I, Christopher Godier, a Special Agent of the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), being duly sworn, depose and state:

I am a Special Agent of the Drug Enforcement Administration and have been so employed since August 2003. I am currently assigned to the Albuquerque District Office of the DEA, specifically assigned to investigate federal drug offenses.

This affidavit is made in support of the issuance of a Criminal Complaint charging Celido Zamudio-Beltran and Miram Rivera-Gambino with violation of Title 21 U.S.C. Section 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C), possession with intent to distribute less than 50 grams of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine.

On November 17, 2010, Albuquerque Drug Enforcement Administration Agents served a Federal Search Warrant signed by U.S. Magistrate Judge Robert Hayes Scott at 637 Pittard Dr. SW, Albuquerque, NM.


Agents located Celido Zamudio-Beltran and his wife Miram Rivera-Gambino in bed in an upstairs bedroom. Both advised that they reside at 637 Pittard Dr. SW, Albuquerque, NM.

Agents also encountered Maria Delores Hernandez and her husband Sergio Arturo Amezcua, and two small children all sleeping in a downstairs bedroom. Agents learned that Hernandez and Amezcua do not reside at 637 Pittard Dr. SW, and were only there visiting from California. They had arrived on Thursday, November 11, 2010.


SA Maestas located a large amount of drug packaging in the kitchen area of the residence and approximately 68 gross grams of methamphetamine lying on top of the refrigerator with a small black digital scale. SA Maestas also located approximately 68.2 gross grams of suspected heroin in a kitchen cabinet of the residence.

SA Maestas spoke to Hernandez and Rivera-Gambino and both claimed no knowledge of the methamphetamine or the heroin found in the residence. SA Maestas also spoke to Celido Zamudio Beltran and claimed no knowledge of drugs or drug packaging found in the residence. SA Maestas spoke to Sergio Arturo Amezcua and he also claimed no knowledge of the drugs or drug packaging found in the residence.

SA Gerald Maestas field tested the suspected methamphetamine and obtained a presumptive positive result for the presence of methamphetamine.
