INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT 1

On or about the June 20, 2010, in Indian Country, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **STERLING SILVERSMITH**, an Indian, did knowingly and unlawfully, assault the person of Donavan Bitsilly, with a dangerous weapon, to wit: a knife, with intent to do bodily harm.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153 and 113(a)(3).

COUNT 2

On or about the June 20, 2010, in Indian Country, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **STERLING SILVERSMITH**, an Indian, did
