STATEMENT OF FACTS

On March 31, 2010 Jesus VALLEJOS contacted a reliable DEA confidential source (CS) and asked if the CS was interested in purchasing methamphetamine. The CS indicated (s)he was and would be ready the following day, April 1, 2010. On April 1, 2010 VALLEJOS called the CS and said the CS should meet VALLEJOS at VALLEJOS' residence to discuss the sale. The CS went to VALLEJOS' residence in Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico. The two negotiated for the CS to purchase two ounces of methamphetamine for \$3200.00 dollars. VALLEJOS told the CS he would contact his source and then call the CS.

At approximately 3:46pm agents searched the CS and the CS vehicle for currency and contraband with negative results. The CS was provided with \$3200.00 US currency. Agents surveilled the CS back to VALLEJOS' residence and observed the CS enter. Agents monitored the meeting via a transmitter.

At approximately 4:23pm agents observed a vehicle with one occupant arrive and the driver go into the residence. VALLEJOS introduced the second person as "PANCHO". PANCHO asked the CS what the CS was looking for and the CS replied, "Two." PANCHO removed two baggies of white powder from his pocket and handed them to the CS, who then handed PANCHO the \$3200.00 US currency, which PANCHO counted and then put in his pocket.

At approximately 4:26pm agents observed the CS depart the residence and the CS was followed to a prearranged location where the CS turned over the two baggies of powder. The CS and CS vehicle were searched again by agents with negative results.

On April 6, 2010 agents showed the CS a photo of Joshua BUENROSTRO and the CS positively identified BUENROSTRO and PANCHO as being the same person.

The baggies of powder were submitted to the DEA Laboratory in Dallas, Texas and were determined to contain 34.2 grams of pure methamphetamine.
