The grand jury charges:

Count 1

On or about September 20, 2013, within the Southern District of California, defendant KHAMSOUK INTHAVONG, aka Speedy, being a person who had previously been convicted in a court, that is, the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, that is, on or about May 1, 2003, of Burglary, in violation of California Penal Code, Section 459, did knowingly and unlawfully possess in and affecting commerce ammunition, that is, twenty-one rounds of 7.62mm Smith & Wesson ammunition; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

3 their reference fully incorporated herein for the purpose of alleging
4 forfeiture to the United States of America pursuant to the provisions

6 States Code, Section 2461(c).


7 2. Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count 1, defendant

11 ammunition involved in the commission of the offense, including, but

13 a. twenty-one rounds of 7.62mm Smith & Wesson
14 ammunition.


