

On June 25, 2002, beginning at 8:30 am, the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit, will hear argument on the appeal of the conviction and sentence of Frederick C. Brandau. The issues which will be argued are as follows: whether there is sufficient evidence to sustain the conviction; whether the length of sentence is cruel and unusual; and whether the victims were vulnerable as defined by the law.
