

On July 23, 2002, the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit affirmed the conviction of Frederick C. Brandau. In a 23 page opinion the court found that the evidence was sufficient to uphold the findings of guilt on 43 counts, including mail fraud and money laundering. In addition, the court affirmed the 55 year sentence imposed by the district court. The opinion can be found at United States v. Frederick C. Brandau, No. 01-10497.
