
Dear Judge McMahon,

The Government writes to respectfully advise the Court that it has served on counsel for defendant, pursuant to the Order of Forfeiture entered in the above-referenced case (the "Forfeiture Order"), Docket Item 34 ¶ 5, and Rule 32.2(b)(3) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, a set of interrogatories and document requests seeking information to identify and locate forfeitable property to satisfy the fully unpaid \$79,434.49 money judgment imposed by the Forfeiture Order. The Government believes that the defendant terminated his publicly funded pension membership and received a payment as a result, and these discovery requests seek to locate these and other assets to satisfy the Forfeiture Order. If the Government locates assets it seeks to forfeit, it will make a further application to this Court under Rule 32.2(e).
