I N F O R M A T I O N

The United States Attorney Charges:

1. At all relevant times, J.P. Morgan Chase Bank ("Chase Bank") was a financial institution within the meaning of 18 U.S.C. § 20, and was located in Charleston, West Virginia, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

2. At all relevant times, defendant MARK A. MCCOY was employed by Chase Bank in Charleston, West Virginia, as Vice President, Private Client Banker.

3. On or about January 19, 2011, at or near Charleston, Kanawha County, West Virginia, and within the Southern District of West Virginia and elsewhere, defendant MARK A. MCCOY, with intent to injure and defraud Chase Bank, did knowingly embezzle, abstract, purloin and willfully misapply moneys of Chase Bank in an amount of approximately \$59,900.00.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 656.
