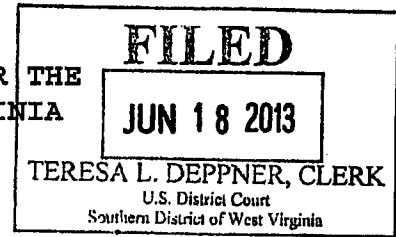

I N D I C T M E N T

The Grand Jury Charges:

On or about May 30, 2012, at or near Bluefield, Mercer County, West Virginia, within the Southern District of West Virginia, defendant BRETT DAVID BOWYER, having been charged with violating Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252A(a)(5)(B) and 2252A(b)(2), a felony offense punishable by imprisonment for a term of 5 years or more, and having been released pursuant to Chapter 207 of Title 18, United States Code, in connection with the aforementioned criminal charge, for appearance before the Honorable David J. Faber, Senior United States District Court Judge, at Bluefield, Mercer County, West Virginia on May 30, 2012, for sentencing in case number 1:11-cr-00159, entitled United States v. Brett David Bowyer, did knowingly and willfully fail to appear as required by the conditions of release.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections
3146(a)(1), 3146(b)(1)(A)(ii) and 3146(b)(2).
