

I N D I C T M E N T

The Grand Jury Charges:

1. On or about March 24, 2012, at or near Belle, Kanawha County, West Virginia, and within the Southern District of West Virginia, defendant DORSEY WOOLWINE, JR. did knowingly possess the following firearms in and affecting interstate commerce:

- a. a Stevens Model 311, 12-Gauge double barrel shotgun, no serial number;
- b. a Remington 870 Magnum shotgun, serial number C196495A;
- c. a Ruger P90, .45 caliber pistol, serial number 661-11940;
- d. Smith & Wesson model 500 revolver, serial number CJA4373;
- e. a Remington, .338 caliber Magnum, serial number B6820439;

- f. a Browning, 10-Gauge shotgun, serial number 36534PP192;
- g. a Remington, 30-06 rifle, serial number B7220005;
- h. a Remington, 30-06 Sportsman rifle, serial number 8396754;
- i. Savage, 30-06 rifle, serial number 4745250;
- j. Jennings Firearms, model J22, serial number 238661;
- k. RG model RG14 revolver, serial number L726602;
- l. Iver Johnson model 55A, no serial number;
- m. Heritage Rough Rider, .22 Magnum, serial number HR77539;
- n. RG model RG14 revolver, serial number 451775;
- o. Ruger 10/22 rifle, serial number 23566401;
- p. Savage 22 caliber, bolt action rifle, serial number 0502918;
- q. Marlin .22 caliber semi-automatic rifle, serial 08271587;
- r. Remington .243 caliber rifle, serial number 71304083; and
- s. Mossberg model 352, .22 caliber rifle, no serial number.


2. At the time defendant DORSEY WOOLWINE, JR. possessed the aforesaid firearms, he had been convicted of a crime which was punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 921(a)(20), that is, convicted on or about June 16, 2003, in the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, West

Virginia, of unlawful wounding, in violation of West Virginia Code § 61-2-9(a).

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).
