HOT LINE FOR REPORTING
INFORMATION CONCERNING GUN CRIMES

United States Attorney Anthony J. Jenkins notifies the public that there is a hot line telephone number which any citizen may call to report information concerning illegal gun crimes in the United States Virgin Islands. The telephone number is:

340-776-4867

During business hours that phone is answered by a member of the staff of the United States Attorney's Office. If that person is not available, the phone will automatically roll-over to an extension in the ATF office and during business hours it will be answered. Should that ATF representative not be available or it is after regular business hours, a caller may leave a recorded message. If the caller does not wish to leave a recorded message they should, during business hours, call the United States Attorney's Office front desk. On St. Thomas/St. John the number is 340-774-5757 and on St. Croix the number is 340-773-3920. Any citizen wishing to report information concerning gun offenses, or any crime, may also contact local and federal law enforcement. All information concerning criminal acts from the public is important and should be reported to law enforcement. Remaining silent allows criminals to commit additional crimes in this community. US Attorney Jenkins echoed the message issued by Governor deJongh that Virgin Islanders can no longer tolerate the level of violence in our community and that the support of the community is essential to successfully addressing crime issues. US Attorney Jenkins asked that every Virgin Islander recognize that the entire community is victimized by every act of violence as these acts of violence make us all feel less safe and less free to live our lives in peace.
