**ORDER GRANTING THE UNITED STATES MOTION
FOR ALTERNATIVE VICTIM NOTIFICATION PROCEDURES**

The United States having moved the Court for an order permitting an alternative means for notification of victims in this case under 18 U.S.C. § 3771(d)(2), and the Court having considered said motion, conducting a hearing in open court, and being otherwise advised, it is hereby ordered and adjudged that the motion be, and the same hereby is, sustained to the extent provided in this Order.

All future notifications to individual victims of information required by the Crime Victims' Rights Act may be made through an initial publication of this matter through a press release issued

across the State of Michigan and in Northern Indiana that directs potential victims to the U.S. Attorney's Office and a website containing the information about the case and Victims' Rights. The U.S. Attorney's Office will also maintain a copy of this press release on its public website.

The U.S. Attorney's Office shall file a copy of the proposed press release in not less than seven (7) days from the date of this order. Any party may object to the proposed press release in not less than seven (7) days following the filing of the proposed press release.

If the government believes alternate notice procedures are necessary or appropriate for entity victims (including without limitation, Medicaid, Medicare (including Part D-private contractors), and private pay carriers), the government will file a motion with the Court.
