## **ROCHESTER WOMAN IS SENTENCED ON BANK FRAUD CHARGES**

ROCHESTER, N.Y.-- U.S. Attorney William J. Hochul, Jr. announced today that Ashley Hall, 24, of Rochester, N.Y., who was convicted of bank fraud, was sentenced to time served and four years supervised release by U.S. District Judge David G. Larimer. Judge Larimer also ordered the defendant to pay \$10,760.28 in restitution.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Tiffany H. Lee, who handled the case, stated that in the summer of 2008, the defendant cashed counterfeit checks at various banks and retailers in the Western District of New York.

The sentencing is the culmination of an investigation on the part of Special Agents of the United States Secret Service, under the direction of Special Agent in Charge Tracy Gast as well as investigators from the Monroe County Sheriff's Office's Economic Crimes Unit under the direction of Sheriff Patrick O'Flynn.
