## **ROCHESTER MAN SENTENCED TO SIX YEARS IN PRISON FOR DRUG CONVICTION**

ROCHESTER, N.Y.-- U.S. Attorney William J. Hochul, Jr. announced today that Terry Baker, 21, of Rochester, N.Y., who was convicted of possession with intent to distribute five grams or more of cocaine base, was sentenced to 72 months in prison by U.S. District Judge David G. Larimer.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Jennifer Noto, who handled the case, stated that the Rochester Police Department executed a search warrant at 93 Thomas Street in the City of Rochester in July 2010. Officers apprehended the defendant as he jumped out of the bathroom window. Inside, officers located approximately 23 grams of cocaine base and a loaded handgun. Baker admitted to police that he sold crack from the location and that the handgun was in the house for protection.

The sentencing is the culmination of an investigation on the part of Special Agents of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, under the direction of Scott L. Heagney and officers of the Rochester Police Department, under the direction of Chief James Sheppard.
