## **ROCHESTER MAN SENTENCED ON DRUG AND WEAPONS CHARGES**

ROCHESTER, N.Y. - U.S. Attorney William J. Hochul, Jr. announced today that Christopher Dunbar, 20, of Rochester, N.Y., who was convicted of possession with intent to distribute marijuana and possession of a loaded firearm in furtherance of narcotics trafficking, was sentenced to 70 months in prison by U.S. District Judge David G. Larimer.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Douglas E. Gregory, who handled the prosecution of the case, stated that Dunbar's residence at 71 Sixth Street was the subject of a search warrant on September 6, 2011. Inside, officers located a Hi-Point 9 millimeter handgun loaded with eight rounds of ammunition, along with numerous rounds of 12 gauge shotgun and .22 caliber ammunition. Officers also located a large quantity of marijuana, packaging materials and scales.

The sentencing is the culmination of an investigation on the part of special agents of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, under the direction of Resident Agent in Charge Scott Heagney, along with officers and investigators with the Rochester Police Department, under the direction of Chief James Sheppard.
