MAN SENTENCED IN FELON IN POSSESSION OF AMMUNITION CASE

ROCHESTER, N.Y.-- U.S. Attorney William J. Hochul, Jr. announced today that Jesus Hernandez, 24, of Rochester, NY, who was convicted of felon in possession of ammunition, was sentenced to 21 months in prison by U.S. District Judge Charles J. Siragusa.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Jennifer M. Noto, who handled the case, stated that the defendant purchased ammunition at a Wal-Mart store located in Greece, New York after having been previously convicted of criminal possession of a weapon in Monroe County Court in December 2004.

The sentencing is the culmination of an investigation on the part of Special Agents of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, under the direction of Acting Residence Agent in Charge Dixon Robin and officers of the New York State Division of Parole.
