BUFFALO MAN SENTENCED ON FIREARMS CHARGES

BUFFALO, N.Y.--U.S. Attorney William J. Hochul, Jr. announced today that Isaiah Glover, 30, of Buffalo, N.Y., who was convicted of being a felon in possession of a firearm, was sentenced to 110 months in prison by U.S. District Judge Richard J. Arcara.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Melissa M. Marangola, who handled the case, stated that on July 21, 2009, officers executed a search warrant at a home on Balcum St. where the defendant was staying. They discovered cocaine and drug paraphernalia in close proximity to a firearm. Glover was previously convicted of a felony.

The conviction is the culmination of an investigation on the part of Buffalo Police Department, under the direction of Commissioner Daniel Derenda and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, under the direction of Resident Agent in Charge Frank Christiano.
