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WOMAN SENTENCED IN BANK FRAUD CASE

BUFFALO, N.Y.-- U.S. Attorney William J. Hochul, Jr. announced today that Natasha Jemison, 29, of Buffalo, New York, State, who was convicted of Bank Fraud on December 8, 2011, was sentenced to time served, restitution and 2 years supervised release by Chief U.S. District Judge William M. Skretny.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Marie P. Grisanti, who handled the case, stated that between on or about November 2009 through March 2010, in the Western District of New York, the defendant, along co-defendant, Latisha Siplin, cashed and attempted to cash 19 checks totaling \$9,350 which were drawn on accounts that had insufficient funds.

The conviction was the culmination of an investigation on the part of Special Agents of the United States Secret Service, under the direction of Tracy Gast, Special Agent In Charge.

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
