## **MAN SENTENCED FOR FALSE CLAIM OF U.S. CITIZENSHIP**

BUFFALO, N.Y.-- U.S. Attorney William J. Hochul, Jr. announced today that Babatunde Olayiwola, a/k/a Dmico Cardell Graham, 40, of Nigeria, pleaded guilty to making a false claim of U.S. citizenship and was sentenced to time served by Chief U.S. District Judge William M. Skretny.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Marie P. Grisanti, who handled the case, stated that the defendant attempted to enter the U.S. at the Peace Bridge on June 10, 2011. Olayiwola claimed to be a U.S. citizen by using a Pennsylvania driver's license in the name of another individual.

The plea and sentencing are the culmination of an investigation on the part of officers with U.S. Customs and Border Protection, under the direction of James T. Engleman, Director of Field Operations.
