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ROCHESTER WOMAN SENTENCED IN BANK FRAUD CASE

ROCHESTER, N.Y.-- U.S. Attorney William J. Hochul, Jr. announced today that Jessica Savage, 31, of Rochester, NY, who was convicted of bank fraud, was sentenced to five years supervised release and ordered to pay \$21,768.60 in restitution by U.S. District Judge David G. Larimer.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Tiffany H. Lee, who handled the case, stated that in the summer of 2008, the defendant cashed counterfeit checks at various banks and retailers in the Western District of New York.

The plea was the culmination of an investigation on the part of Special Agents of the United States Secret Service, under the direction of Special Agent in Charge Tracy Gast as well as investigators from the Monroe County Sheriff's Office's Economic Crimes Unit under the direction of Sheriff Patrick O'Flynn.

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
