Proof of ID and Social Security Number

Beginning with cases filed on March 1, 2002, the United States Trustee will require bankruptcy debtors to provide to the trustee, at the meeting of creditors, satisfactory proof of identity and proof of social security number. Debtors will need to bring both picture ID and proof of social security number to the meeting. Acceptable proof is listed below.

*** ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED ***

A. Picture ID:

- 1) state driver's license
- 2) government ID
- 3) state ID
- 4) student ID
- 5) U.S. passport
- 6) military ID
- 7) resident alien card
- 8) Mexican consulate card ("matricula consular")

B. Proof of SSN:

- 1) social security card
- 2) medical insurance card
- 3) pay stub
- 4) W-2 form
- 5) Internal Revenue Service Form 1099
- 6) Social Security Administration report
