ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PERMANENT INJUNCTION

The parties have filed a Joint Motion for Entry of Permanent Injunction by Consent (the "Motion") [ECF No. 11]. After careful review, the Motion is hereby **GRANTED** as follows:

- A. Pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 7402(a), the Defendant, Napoleon Tabot, is **PERMANENTLY ENJOINED** from directly or indirectly:
 - 1. Preparing, assisting in the preparation of, or directing the preparation of federal tax returns, amended returns, or other tax-related documents or forms, including any electronically submitted tax returns or tax-related documents, for any entity or person other than himself;
 - 2. Filing, assisting in the filing of, or directing the filing of federal tax returns, amended returns, or other tax-related documents or forms, including any electronically submitted tax returns or tax-related documents, for any entity or person other than himself;
 - 3. Owning, managing, assisting, or working at a business that prepares or assists in the preparation of tax returns, amended returns, or other tax-related documents or forms, including any electronically submitted tax returns or tax-related documents;

- 4. Maintaining, assigning, holding, using, or obtaining a Preparer Tax Identification Number (PTIN) or an Electronic Filing Identification Number (EFIN);
- 5. Training, advising, counselling, instructing, or teaching anyone about the preparation of federal tax returns;
- 6. Engaging in any conduct that substantially interferes with the proper administration and enforcement of the internal revenue laws.
- B. The United States will be allowed full post-judgment discovery to monitor compliance with the permanent injunction.
- C. This Court will retain jurisdiction over this action for purposes of implementing and enforcing the permanent injunction and any additional orders necessary and appropriate to the public interest.
- D. The Clerk of Court is directed to **CLOSE** this case. All pending deadlines and hearings are **TERMINATED**, and any pending motions are **DENIED** as moot.
