

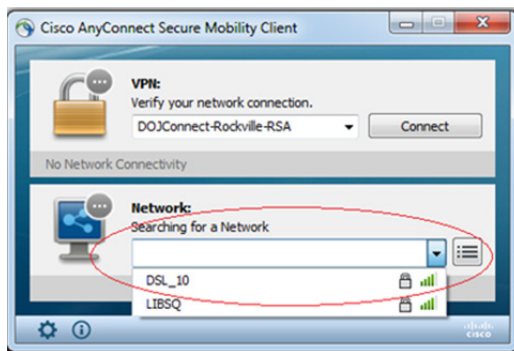
Remote Access using your PIVCard

The new laptops support remote access connections with your RSA token or your PIVCard. The remote access software, Cisco AnyConnect, now supports wireless networks.

If you are working remotely and do not have your PIVCard you must contact 6-TAXI at 202-616-8294. You will need your username and password in order to connect without your PIVCard. Please be sure to have this information available prior to contacting 6-TAXI.

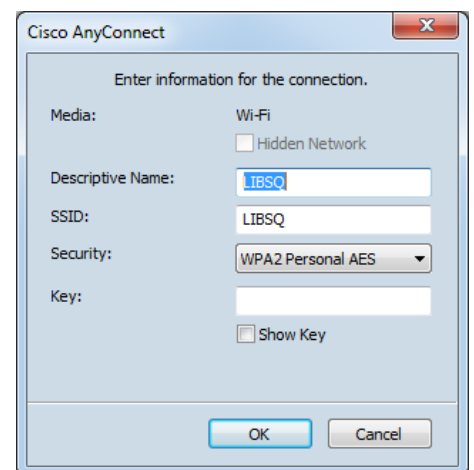
To connect wirelessly using your PIVCard:

1. At the Windows Login screen, insert your PIVCard and select Switch user.
2. Click the Network Logon icon located in the lower right corner of the screen. *You will be presented with the Cisco AnyConnect dialog.*

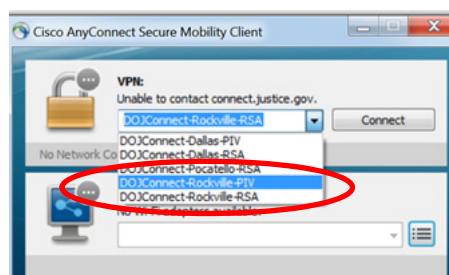


Available wireless connections will be listed in the Network dropdown menu. Click the menu to display available connections and select a wireless network.

NOTE: If this is your first time selecting this connection enter the wireless password in the Key: field and click OK. *Cisco AnyConnect will remember the wireless connection details and automatically connect next time.*

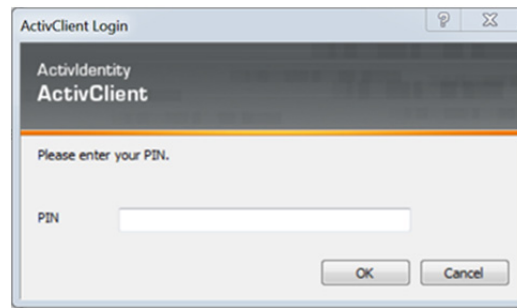


3. Click the VPN dropdown menu and select the DOJConnection-Rockville-PIV connection. Click Connect.

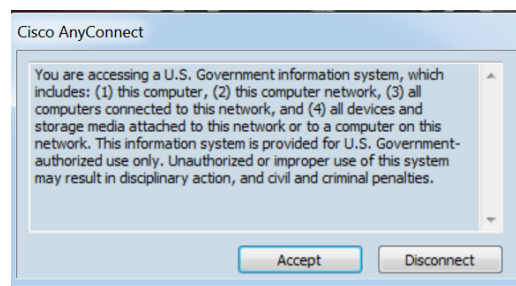


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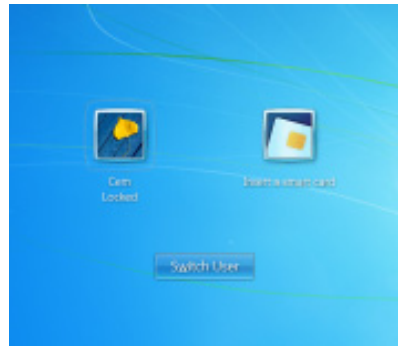
4. The ActivClient Login dialog will be displayed. Enter your PIVCard PIN and click OK.



5. At the Cisco AnyConnect dialog click Accept.



6. You will be taken back to the Windows Login screen. Click Insert a smart card.



7. Enter your PIVCard PIN again and press ENTER. *You will be connected to the network and all drives will be mapped.*
