11 12	penalties or testifies or otherwise participates in any proceedings concerning the 90%	
12	Stock Loan and 90% QRP Loan transactions, directly or indirectly, alleged in the	
14	Complaint.5. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over this action for purposes of	
15	implementing and enforcing this Stipulated Injunction.
