FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION AGAINST LINDA HENDRIETH

Plaintiff, the United States of America, filed a complaint for permanent injunction against the defendant, Linda Hendrieth. The defendant consents to entry of a permanent injunction.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

- 1. The Court has jurisdiction over this action under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1340 and 1345 and under 26 U.S.C. §§ 7402 and 7407.
- 2. Linda Hendrieth is permanently enjoined from acting as an income tax preparer under 26 U.S.C. §§ 7402 and 7407, including, but not limited to the following:
 - a) preparing any Federal income tax returns or claims for refund; and
- b) engaging in any conduct that interferes with the administration and enforcement of the internal revenue laws by the Internal Revenue Service; and
 - c) engaging in activity subject to penalty under 26 U.S.C. § 6701.
- 3. It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Linda Hendrieth provide to all persons for whom she has since 1999 prepared tax returns, a copy of this order. In addition, Linda Hendrieth, shall file with the Court within thirty (30) days of this date a certification signed under penalty of perjury that she has done so.
- 4. It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that within thirty (30) days of this order Linda Hendrieth shall produce to counsel for the United States a list



of her current and former customers for whom she prepared Federal income tax returns since January 1, 1999 identifying each customer by name, address, and taxpayer identification numbers.

5. It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the United States may engage in post-judgment discovery to monitor compliance with this injunction, and that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this action for the purpose of implementing and enforcing this Final Judgment and all additional decrees and orders necessary and appropriate to the public interest.
