We are pleased to invite you to a government-to-government consultation with the U.S. Department of Justice on the results of the Alaska Pilot Program authorized by the Violence Against Women Act Reauthorization Act of 2022 (VAWA 2022), including any modifications to law necessary to facilitate improved law enforcement in Alaska Native Villages. The Tribal views received during this consultation will be included in a report to Congress, as mandated by VAWA 2022. *See* 25 U.S.C. § 1305(h). A framing paper providing additional background information and outlining issues for discussion accompanies this letter.
