Purpose Area #5 Tribal Government Program (OVW)

In a separate document, applicants must include a high-quality project abstract that summarizes the proposed project in 400 words or less. Abstracts should be

- a. written for a general public audience;
- b. submitted as a separate attachment with “Project Abstract” as part of its file name (this will **NOT** count against the page limit for the program narrative);
- c. single-spaced, using a standard 12-point font (Times New Roman) with 1-inch margins.

The abstract should include a brief description of the project’s purpose, the population to be served, and the activities that the applicant will implement to achieve the project’s goals and objectives. The abstract should be specific to the project proposed for this purpose area. See the following examples based on applicant type. **It is strongly encouraged that applicants use one of the formats below.**
