**TAP team provides a single workstation with a cabinet and specs are as follows:**

Hardware and Software:

- DOJ will provide a personal computer (PC) with the MESA application to access NGI, a set of web browsers (to access LEEP, N-DEx, and NICS), monitor, keyboard, mouse, livescan, camera, flatbed scanner, printer, and power supply.

Cabinet:

- DOJ will provide a cabinet that will “house” the following items: DOJ PC, monitor, keyboard, mouse, livescan, camera, and power supply.
- The Tribe will provide table or desk for the flatbed scanner and printer.

## Select Camera Placement

Camera is above on the Left or Right side of the Kiosk, think about where you will place the Kiosk in relation to walls and obstacles, and where you want the operator to stand in relation to the person being photographed and fingerprinted.



Camera on the Left side of the Monitor, Kiosk Operator will be to the right side of the person being photographed and fingerprinted.

Camera on the Right side of the Monitor, Kiosk Operator will be to the Left side of the person being photographed and fingerprinted.
