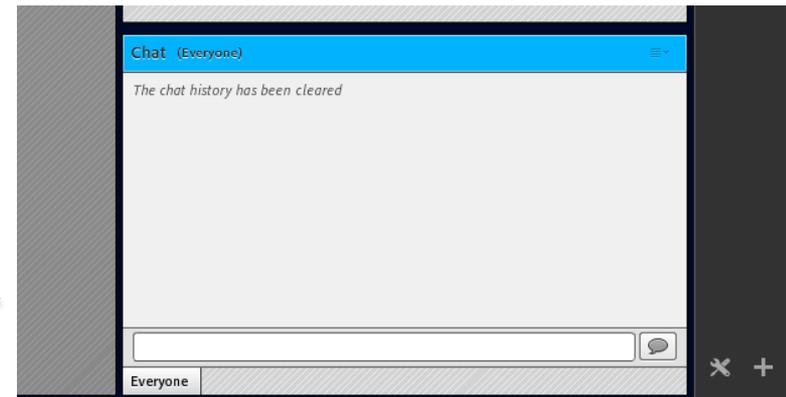

What is the N-DEx System?



- N-DEx is a national investigative information sharing system that provides access to national records that allows investigators to work with others across the nation in a collaborative environment.
- N-DEx contains the underlying records held by criminal justice agencies.
- N-DEx provides access to records shared by more than 6,300 criminal justice agencies and includes incident reports, arrest reports, service calls, bookings, citations/tickets, prison and jail records, field contact, photographs, interviews, and other information.



What is the N-DEx System (cont'd)



John Walsh Talks N-DEx



- Police can conduct queries in the National Data Exchange (N-DEx) to obtain national historical case information and cross-check police reports for investigative purposes.
- N-DEx permits law enforcement personnel to search local, state, tribal, and federal criminal justice records to:
 - share valuable case information in a secure real-time environment
 - use advanced analytical tools to graphically depict investigations
 - detect relationships between people, events, property, and locations
 - identify hot spots of criminal activity
 - receive notification when new records of interest enter the system or when another user searches similar interests.



- Access is through the Law Enforcement Enterprise Portal (LEEP) and requires a LEEP Account
- User must be approved for access by the Tribal N-DEx Agency Coordinator (NAC) who is usually the tribe's Terminal Agency Coordinator (TAC)

- Tribe utilized N-DEx to locate the suspect and kidnapped vulnerable adult quickly; without N-Dex, the investigation would have taken much longer and the vulnerable adult would have been located and recovered much later, if at all
