THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT 1

On or about May 20, 2022, in the District of Arizona, the defendant, ENRRIQUE RICARDO DIAZ VAZQUEZ, willfully and knowingly made a false statement in an application for a passport with intent to induce and secure for his own use the issuance of a passport under the authority of the United States, contrary to the laws regulating the issuance of such passports and the rules prescribed pursuant to such laws, in that in such application he represented under penalty of perjury that 1) he was Gene Edward Katzorke, 2) he was born on August 6, 1964, 3) he was born in Tucson, Arizona and 4) he was a United States Citizen.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1542.

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COUNT 2

On or about August 1, 2024, in the District of Arizona, the defendant, ENRRIQUE RICARDO DIAZ VAZQUEZ, willfully and knowingly made a false statement in an application for a passport with intent to induce and secure for his own use the issuance of a passport under the authority of the United States, contrary to the laws regulating the issuance of such passports and the rules prescribed pursuant to such laws, in that in such application he represented under penalty of perjury that 1) he was Gene Edward Katzorke, 2) he was born on August 6, 1964, 3) he was born in Tucson, Arizona and 4) he was a United States Citizen.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1542.
