The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

On or about January 24, 2024, within the District of Columbia, Antoine L. Harvell wrongfully obtained and used property of value, belonging to Macy's or the lawful agent thereof, consisting of store merchandise, with the intent to appropriate the property for his own use and to deprive Macy's or the lawful agent thereof of a right to and benefit of the property. (Second Degree Theft - Felony, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 3211, 3212(c) (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about January 24, 2024, within the District of Columbia, Antoine L. Harvell, without lawful authority, did enter and attempt to enter certain property, that is, Macy's, against the will of Macy's or the lawful agent thereof, the lawful occupant thereof and the person lawfully in charge thereof. (Unlawful Entry (Private Property), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 3302(a)(1) (2001 ed.))
