The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

On or about October 20, 2023, within the District of Columbia, Sterling W. McLaughlin wrongfully obtained and used property of value, belonging to [REDACTED] Church, consisting of a package containing a microphone and stand, with the intent to appropriate the property for his own use and to deprive [REDACTED] Church of a right to and benefit of the property. (Second Degree Theft - Felony, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 3211, 3212(c) (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about January 3, 2024, within the District of Columbia, Sterling W. McLaughlin wrongfully obtained and used property of value, belonging to [REDACTED], consisting of a package containing merchandise, with the intent to appropriate the property for his own use and to deprive [REDACTED] of a right to and benefit of the property. (Second Degree Theft - Felony, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 3211, 3212(c) (2001 ed.))
