We have had a good response so far, and we hope that even more of you will respond to this Victim Access Survey and complete it as soon as possible. Recently, on September 18, 2024, the Court issued a new Order requiring us to provide the Court with the total number of victims who wish to have remote access to the court proceedings and geographic locations for each victim, to assist the Court in making “reasonable efforts” to provide remote access to victims. As we have previously informed you, we have sought to have the Court utilize the Zoom for Government platform to make court proceedings available to you on your personal devices, while the defense has recommended that the Court use fixed sites, such as federal courthouses, to provide remote access. The Court has not ruled yet, but has asked that this information be provided to it **by October 16, 2024, to make its ruling**. Thus, the information you are providing about your physical location, any financial, physical, medical, and logistical hardships, and potential travel restrictions you may face in attending to view trial at fixed sites, will be helpful to us as we make our arguments to the Court.

**Given the court’s new date imposed, we urge you to complete your Victim Access Survey no later than October 9, 2024**, so that we may have enough time to process your responses for the Court’s consideration.
