SUPERIOR COURT UPDATE: OCTOBER 2024

Between January 1 and October 31, 2024:

- 8,439 **cases** charged in D.C. Superior Court
 - 2,568 defendants charged with at least one felony offense
- 1,140 **felony** cases indicted in D.C. Superior Court
- 1,568 guilty pleas in felony D.C. Superior Court cases
- 504 trials in D.C. Superior Court

As of October 31, 2024: 2,905 active felony prosecutions in D.C. Superior Court
