INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT ONE

On or about March 20, 2025, within the District of Columbia, **DION ZELLARS**, also known as **THOMAS GOOD**, knowing he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, in the Superior Court for the District of Columbia, Criminal Case Nos. 2010CF2005414 and 2015CF1003336, and in the Circuit Court for Prince George's County, Maryland, Criminal Case Nos. CT061877X and CT110093X, did unlawfully and knowingly receive and possess a firearm, that is, a Glock 29 10mm with Serial number BNTD074, and did unlawfully and knowingly receive and possess ammunition, that is, 15 rounds

of 10mm ammunition, which had been possessed, shipped, and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce.

(Unlawful Possession of a Firearm and Ammunition by a Person Convicted of a Crime Punishable by Imprisonment for a Term Exceeding One Year, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1))

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count One of this Indictment, the defendant shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm and ammunition involved in or used in the knowing commission of the offense, including but not limited to a Glock 29 10mm with Serial number BNTD074, and 10mm ammunition.

(Criminal Forfeiture, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c))
