MR. AL-MARIMI'S MOTION TO EXCEED PAGE LIMITS

Abu Agila Al-Marimi, through counsel, hereby moves the Court for permission to exceed the page limits set by local rule for his Reply to His Motion in Limine Regarding Government's Trial Exhibits [ECF 507], given the format of the objections. In support of this motion, Mr. Al-Marimi states the following:

Local Criminal Rule 47(e) provides a 25-page limit for a reply memorandum. Because of the format of the objections to the exhibits – namely, a table containing the initial objection, the government’s response, and the defense reply – the overall brief is 48 pages long. However, the tables account for approximately 30 of those pages, leaving less than 20 pages of written analysis and argument.¹

Accordingly, Mr. Al-Marimi, moves the Court for permission to exceed the page

1 Defense counsel felt it would be most helpful to place the tables of the individual exhibit objections immediately following the analysis and argument section for each category of objection. Should the Court prefer, defense counsel could refile the reply brief and place the tables in an appendix to the legal argument. In any event, defense counsel intends to provide the Court with an index, listing each exhibit by number and lists by name all objections to that particular exhibit.
