MINUTE ORDER as to ABU AGILA MOHAMMAD MAS'UD KHEIR AL-MARIMI granting the defendant's [658] Motion to Continue Trial. It is ORDERED that the August 26, 2026, trial date is VACATED. A status conference is scheduled for September 1, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 24A. For the reasons previously stated on the record -- namely the complex nature of the case, the amount of time required to adequately prepare for pretrial proceedings and for trial, see 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(B)(ii), the voluminous discovery, including newly discovered evidence, as well as evidence located in other countries, id. § 3161(h)(8), and the need for the defense to determine how best to defend this case, see id. § 3161(h)(7)(B)(iv) -- the Court finds that the "ends of justice...outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial." 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A). Accordingly, pursuant to the Speedy Trial Act and with the defendant's consent, the time from August 26, 2026, through September 1, 2026, shall be excluded in computing the date for a speedy trial in this case.
