January 25, 2023 Status Update – Ascertainment of Counsel Hearing

We write to provide you with an update on our efforts to prosecute Abu Agila Mohammad Mas'ud Kheir al-Marimi for his alleged role in the attack on your loved ones in the bombing of Pan Am 103.

The <u>Ascertainment of Counsel Hearing</u> was held on January 25, 2023 and a Federal Public Defender, Whitney Minter, was appointed the defendant's attorney. Also, the defendant was informed of his consular rights and confirmed that he wanted the U.S. government to notify Libya of his arrest and detention. The government will make that notification.

The Arraignment Hearing that was scheduled for January 25, 2023 at 10:30 am (ET) has been continued until February 8, 2023 at 11:00 am (ET). The purpose of the hearing will be to formally give the defendant notice of his charges, at which the defendant will enter a plea to the charges filed in this case. The government expects the defendant to enter a plea of not guilty at this hearing. Your attendance is not required. The hearing will take place at the E. Barrett Prettyman Courthouse, 333 Constitution, Ave., NW, Washington, DC 20001, in courtroom 5, on the second floor.
