The Grand Jury charges:

FIRST COUNT:

On or about August 18, 2022, within the District of Columbia, Gary Jones, being more than four years older than D.C., a child under sixteen years of age, that is, 10 years of age, engaged in sexual contact with that child, that is, Gary Jones touched D.C.'s buttocks with his hand, with the intent to abuse, humiliate, harass, degrade, and arouse and gratify the sexual desire of any person. (Second Degree Child Sexual Abuse, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 3009 (2001 ed.))

The Grand Jury Further Charges that at the time Gary Jones committed Second Degree Child Sexual Abuse, the victim, D.C., was under the age twelve years.

The Grand Jury Further Charges that Gary Jones has been found guilty of committing sex offenses against 2 or more victims.

(Second Degree Child Sexual Abuse (Aggravating Circumstances), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 3009, 3020(a)(1), 3020(a)(5) (2001 ed.))

SECOND COUNT:

On or about August 18, 2022, within the District of Columbia, Gary Jones, being more than four years older than D.C., a child under sixteen years of age, that is, 10 years of age, engaged in sexual contact with that child, that is, Gary Jones touched D.C.'s buttocks with his hand, with the intent to abuse, humiliate, harass, degrade, and arouse and gratify the sexual desire of any person. (Second Degree Child Sexual Abuse, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 3009 (2001 ed.))

The Grand Jury Further Charges that at the time Gary Jones committed Second Degree Child Sexual Abuse, the victim, D.C., was under the age twelve years.

THIRD COUNT:

On or about August 18, 2022, within the District of Columbia, Gary Jones, being more than four years older than J.S., a child under sixteen years of age, that is, 12 years of age, attempted to engage in sexual contact with that child, that is, Gary Jones attempted to touch J.S.'s buttocks with his hand, with the intent to abuse, humiliate, harass, degrade, and arouse and gratify the sexual desire of any person. (Attempted Second Degree Child Sexual Abuse, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 3009, 3018 (2001 ed.))

The Grand Jury Further Charges that Gary Jones has been found guilty of committing sex offenses against 2 or more victims.

(Attempted Second Degree Child Sexual Abuse (Aggravating Circumstances), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 3009, 3020(a)(5), 3018 (2001 ed.))

FOURTH COUNT:

On or about August 18, 2022, within the District of Columbia, Gary Jones, being 18 years old or older and being more than four years older than D.C. and J.S., children under sixteen years of age, that is, 10 and 12 years of age, respectively, engaged in sexually suggestive conduct with those children that is, masturbated in the presence of D.C. and J.S., which was intended to cause and reasonably did cause the sexual arousal and sexual gratification of any person. (Misdemeanor Sexual Abuse of a Child, in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Section 3010.01 (2001 ed.))

The Grand Jury Further Charges that Gary Jones has been found guilty of committing sex offenses against 2 or more victims.

(Misdemeanor Sexual Abuse of a Child (Aggravating Circumstances), in violation of 22 D.C. Code, Sections 3010.01, 3020(a)(5) (2001 ed.))
