STATUTORY SENTENCES

Conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute and to distribute more than 500 grams of methamphetamine and possession with intent to distribute more than 50 grams of methamphetamine actual is punishable by not less than 10 years, not more than life, incarceration in the Bureau of Prisons with a possible fine of up to \$10,000,000, and not less than 5 years supervised release.

Conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute and to distribute more than 50 grams but less than 500 grams of methamphetamine and possession with intent to distribute more than 5 grams of methamphetamine actual is punishable by not less than 5 years, not more than 40 years, incarceration in the Bureau of Prisons with a possible fine of up to \$5,000,000, and not less than 4 years supervised release.

Possession with intent to distribute less than 50 grams of methamphetamine is punishable by not more than 20 years' incarceration in the Bureau of Prisons with a possible fine of up to \$1,000,000, and not less than 3 years supervised release.

Use of a communication facility to facilitate a drug-trafficking crime is punishable by not more than 4 years' incarceration in the Bureau of Prisons with a possible fine of up to \$250,000, and not more than 1 year supervised release.
