ALERRT has developed a new lecture-based awareness class for all law enforcement, including mid-level and upper administration.

Horrific mass shootings continue to make headlines. One of the first steps to being prepared is to be keenly aware of the threat picture. Significant changes have been made in best practices for active shooter response.

The Driving Force concept is introduced to assist in decision-making during initial response to Stop The Killing. Point-of-injury medical care and evacuation to higher level of care to Stop The Dying.

Introduction to the Integrated Rescue Task Force model, working with Fire and EMS personnel within a warm zone with traditional protocols as well as ambulance exchange point concepts.

To better prepare citizens for active shooter threats; empowering and instilling confidence in the community that they can survive an active shooter event; discuss model civilian response protocols and awareness campaigns.

There is no charge to officers or agencies for this training. It is funded through state and federal grants. Participants are responsible for their own transportation, meals and lodging.
