COUNT TWO: [21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1) – Manufacture of Marijuana]

The Grand Jury further charges: T H A T

### CLEMENTE LOPEZ,

defendant herein, between on or about May 26, 2016 and on or about July 14, 2016, in the County of Trinity, State and Eastern District of California, did knowingly and intentionally manufacture at least 50 marijuana plants, a Schedule I Controlled Substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

# FORFEITURE ALLEGATION: [21 U.S.C. § 853(a) – Criminal Forfeiture]

- 1. Upon conviction of one or more of the offenses alleged in Counts One and Two of this Indictment, defendant CLEMENTE LOPEZ shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(a), the following property:
- a. All right, title, and interest in any and all property involved in violations of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), or conspiracy to commit such offenses, for which defendant is convicted, and all property traceable to such property, including the following: all real or personal property, which constitutes or is derived from proceeds obtained, directly or indirectly, as a result of such offenses; and all property used, or intended to be used, in any manner or part to commit or to facilitate the commission of the offenses.
- b. A sum of money equal to the total amount of proceeds obtained as a result of the offenses, or conspiracy to commit such offenses, for which defendant is convicted.
- 2. If any property subject to forfeiture, as a result of the offenses alleged in Counts One and Two of this Indictment, for which defendant is convicted:
  - a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
  - b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
  - c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
  - d. has been substantially diminished in value; or

has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty; e. it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of defendant, up to the value of the property subject to forfeiture.
