3 PRIOR CONVICTION ALLEGATION:

4 The Grand Jury further alleges that at the time JEFFREY MILES HAYES committed the offense  
5 charged in this Indictment, he had been convicted in 2009 in the Superior Court of the State of  
6 California for Sacramento County for sending or bringing into state for sale or distribution; possessing,  
7 preparing, publishing, producing, developing, duplicating, or printing within the state; matter depicting  
8 sexual conduct by a minor, a violation of California Penal Code Section 311.1(A), such prior conviction  
9 relating to the production, possession, receipt, mailing, sale, distribution, shipment, or transportation of  
10 child pornography.

11 FORFEITURE ALLEGATION: [18 U.S.C. 2253(a) – Criminal Forfeiture]

12 1. Upon conviction of the offense alleged in this Indictment, defendant JEFFREY MILES  
13 HAYES shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2253(a), any and all matter which  
14 contains visual depictions produced, transported, mailed, shipped or received in violation thereof; any  
15 property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds the defendant  
16 obtained as a result of the said violations; and any property, real or personal, used or intended to be  
17 used to commit and promote the commission of the violations, including, but not limited to the  
18 following:

- 19 a. One Apple iPad, serial number DMVGX7VWDFHW; and  
20 b. One Toshiba laptop satellite P25-s520, serial number 44323122k.

21 2. If any property subject to forfeiture as a result of the offense alleged in this Indictment, for  
22 which defendant is convicted:

- 23 a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;  
24 b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;  
25 c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;  
26 d. has been substantially diminished in value; or  
27 e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without  
28 difficulty,

1 it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2253(b), to seek forfeiture of any other  
2 property of said defendant, up to the value of the property subject to forfeiture.





**United States v. Jeffrey Miles Hayes**

**COUNT 1:            JEFFREY MILES HAYES**

VIOLATION:            18 U.S.C. § 2252(a)(2) – Receipt of Child Pornography with a Prior Conviction

PENALTIES:            Mandatory minimum of 15 years in prison and a maximum of up to 40 prison; or  
Fine of up to \$250,000; or both fine and imprisonment  
Supervised release of at least 5 years up to life

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT: \$100 (mandatory on each count)

**FORFEITURE ALLEGATION:    Jeffrey Miles Hayes**

VIOLATION:            21 U.S.C. § 2253(a) – Criminal Forfeiture

PENALTIES:            As stated in the charging document
