**Subject:** Preparation for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP)

---

The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) is encouraging nonprofit organizations and interested parties to prepare for the release of the FY 2019 Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) by the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency. The anticipated total amount of funds distributed nationwide under the FY 2019 NSGP is \$60 million.

The NSGP funding is intended to support the purchase of physical security enhancement and security related training. NSGP funding can be used for the acquisition and installation of security equipment on real property, specifically in the prevention of and/or protection against the risk of terrorist attack. Nonprofit organizations that are eligible to submit applications for the NSGP are those organizations that are described under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (IRC) and exempt from tax under section 501(a) of such code.

In preparation for the release of the FY 2019 NOFO, Cal OES will be conducting two webinars to explain the NSGP requirements, and assist nonprofit organizations with the application process.
