The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

At a time unknown but on or about June 15, 2013 through and including on or about June 26, 2013, the defendant, **BRIAN CARTER**, being an employee of the United States Postal Service, did knowingly steal, abstract, remove from any letter, card, package, or mail articles and things contained therein having been entrusted to him and which came into his possession, intended to be conveyed by mail, two gift cards, to wit: a \$50.00 Target Visa gift card and a \$50.00 Bed Bath and Beyond gift card; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1709.

COUNT 2

On or about August 7, 2013, the defendant, **BRIAN CARTER**, being an employee of the United States Postal Service, did knowingly steal, abstract, remove from any letter, card, package, or mail articles and things contained therein having been entrusted to him and which came into his possession, intended to be conveyed by mail, the following item: a piece of mail addressed to "R.T.," P.O. Box 3478, Baton Rouge, LA 70821, containing \$40.00 in U.S. Currency; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1709.

COUNT 3

On or about August 7, 2013, the defendant, **BRIAN CARTER**, being an employee of the United States Postal Service, did knowingly, unlawfully, and without authority, open a letter, not directed to him, which came into his possession, and was intended to be conveyed by mail, the following item: a piece of mail addressed to "R.T.," P.O. Box 3478, Baton Rouge, LA 70821, containing \$40.00 in U.S. Currency; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1703(a).

COUNT 4

On or about August 7, 2013, the defendant, **BRIAN CARTER**, being an employee of the United States Postal Service, did knowingly, unlawfully, and without authority, open a letter, not directed to him, which came into his possession, and was intended to be conveyed by mail, the following item:

a piece of mail addressed to "G.L." 407 Spartan Loop, Slidell, LA 70458, containing \$35.00 in U.S. Currency; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1703(a).

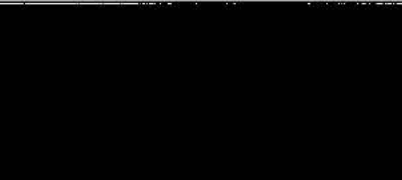
