FACTUAL BASIS

Were this matter brought to trial, the United States would prove, through competent evidence, the following beyond a reasonable doubt.

On or about March 8, 2015, Agents with the Office of Border Patrol (OBP), Customs and Border Protection (CBP), Department of Homeland Security (DHS) were conducting transportation checks at the Union Passenger Terminal (UPT) in New Orleans, Louisiana. Agents encountered and questioned the defendant OSCAR EDUARDO PEÑA-TABORA, also known as "Leobardo Estrada-Maya" (PEÑA-TABORA) who admitted that he was a citizen of Honduras without immigration documents that would permit him to be in the United States.

Records checks revealed that PEÑA-TABORA is, in fact, a citizen of Honduras illegally present in the United States and that he had been previously deported on August 2, 2002.

Since his deportations, PEÑA-TABORA did not receive the requisite consent from the U.S. Attorney General or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, to apply for readmission or receive permission to reenter the United States.
