The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

Beginning at a time unknown but not later than January 1, 2012, and continuing through the date of this Indictment, in the Eastern District of Louisiana and elsewhere, the defendant, **DAMIEN WILSON, a/k/a Super D**, did knowingly and intentionally combine, conspire, confederate and agree with other persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to distribute and to possess with the intent to distribute one kilogram or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I drug controlled substance, in violation of

Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A); all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

COUNT 2

On or about December 16, 2013, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, defendant, **DAMIEN WILSON, a/k/a Super D**, did knowingly and intentionally distribute a quantity of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I drug controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

COUNT 3

On or about March 7, 2014, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, defendant, **DAMIEN WILSON, a/k/a Super D**, did knowingly and intentionally distribute one hundred grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I drug controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(B).

NOTICE OF DRUG FORFEITURE

1. The allegations in Counts 1-3 of this Indictment are alleged and incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States of America pursuant to the provisions of Title 21, United States Code, Section 853.

2. As a result of the offenses alleged in Counts 1-3, the defendant, **DAMIEN WILSON, a/k/a Super D**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds the defendant obtained directly or indirectly as a result of the said violations and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit and to facilitate the commission of the violations alleged in Counts 1-3 of this Indictment.

3. If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property, which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;


it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853 (p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of said defendant up to the value of the above-forfeitable property.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 853.


