



## INDICTMENT FOR THEFT OF MAIL BY POSTAL EMPLOYEE

The Grand Jury charges that:

## COUNT 1

In or about December 2013, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **O'NEIL EDWARDS**, being an employee of the United States Postal Service, did knowingly steal, abstract, remove from any letter, package, bag and mail, which came into his possession intended to be conveyed by mail, the contents of one first-class letter addressed to "C.H.," 127 Magnolia Drive, Belle Chasse, LA 70037 and bearing the return address of "W.H," 4353 Mammoth Creed

Drive, Las Vegas, NV 89147, containing two \$100 GameStop gift cards; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1709.
