The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

ACCESSING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY WITH THE INTENT TO VIEW

Beginning at a time unknown to on or about July 15, 2015, within the Eastern District of Louisiana and elsewhere, the defendant, **CRAIG QUINTAL**, knowingly accessed with intent to view at least one matter that contained visual depictions that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, and that were produced using materials that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in interstate and foreign commerce by any means

including by computer, and the production of such visual depictions involved the use of a minor who was prepubescent and under the age of twelve (12) years-old engaging in sexually explicit conduct, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(2), and the visual depictions were of such conduct.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252(a)(4)(B) and (b)(2).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

1. The allegations of Count One of this Indictment are realleged and incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States of America pursuant to the provisions of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.

2. As a result of the offense(s) alleged in Count One, defendant, **CRAIG QUINTAL**, shall forfeit to the United States all property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from such offenses; and/or any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of such offenses, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252(a)(4)(B) and 2253, including but not limited to:

- a. Two Dell desktop computers;
- b. Seagate external hard drive;
- c. Dell hard drive;
- d. iPhone 3 cellular telephone;
- e. iPhone 4 cellular telephone.

3. If any of the property described above as being subject to forfeiture as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;

- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253(o), to seek forfeiture of any other property of said defendant up to the value of the above forfeitable property.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253.
