FACTUAL BASIS

Were this matter brought to trial, the United States would prove the following by competent evidence beyond a reasonable doubt.

On or about October 1, 2015, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) officers encountered defendant, JIMY NAHUN NUÑEZ-IZAGUIRRE (NUÑEZ-IZAGUIRRE), near his home in New Orleans, Louisiana. NUÑEZ-IZAGUIRRE was taken into ICE custody without incident and transported to the New Orleans Field Office for further processing.

ICE records checks revealed that NUÑEZ-IZAGUIRRE is a citizen of Honduras who had been deported from the United States on or about July 25, 2008. Since his deportation, NUÑEZ-IZAGUIRRE did not receive the requisite consent from the U.S. Attorney General or his designated successor, the Secretary of


the Department of Homeland Security, to apply for readmission or receive permission to reenter the United States.


